- Identify Central Section options for performance and KPI's applicable for service, including: Develop of performance KPI's for inclusion in the operations ITT

Timetables and diagrams

- Work with NR to define train plan for Western section, including challenging established practices
- Develop outline diagrams for rolling stock and traincrew

Lead the timetable development for the Central section including:

- Development of the train plan, informing the infrastructure design based on the requirements of the timetable.
- Production of indicative diagrams and timetables for inclusion within the ITT

- Development of service quality regimes for inclusion in service requirement until 2027
